Enhanced Child Care Referrals.....\$90 (per case)

The Child Care Council can provide employee parents with a custom listing of licensed/registered child care providers based on preferences provided by the parent. The enhanced referral also includes vacancy checks of child care programs, child care provider profiles, and comprehensive educational materials on selecting quality care.

Post-Enrollment Evaluation of Child Care.....\$200

One two-hour observation by an Early Childhood Educator at your child care center, family child care home or nanny. An assessment of the child care environment is conducted and a detailed report is shared with the parent.

Lunch and Learn.....\$250

An Early Childhood Educator will provide a one-hour on-site work and family presentation on any of the following topics:

- Guidance
- Discipline
- Child development
- Nutrition
- Literacy
- Infant/toddler issues
- Academic achievement

Pre-Enrollment Evaluation.....\$250

Before a parent selects a child care program, an Early Childhood Educator will conduct a one-hour observation of the prospective program and provide the parent with a written report. The Early Childhood Educator will also provide the parent with an *environmental rating scale*, a tool used to rate program quality, and assistance in using the scale to help the parent assess the program.
